2016, alc. 12.5%, dry

Grape variety: Plavina (indigenous, Verdeca x Tribidrag)

9. MIRAZ FRANKOVKA, Feravino

2015, alc. 13.5%, dry

Grape variety: Frankovka (Blafränkisch)
